MISC. NOTES:

Leave float plan with responsible person

Clean clothes for return trip

If travelling in extreme cold:

neoprene hood

pogies

warm footwear (neoprene mukluks – chotas, with warm socks)

down jacket

Bug jacket

Fishing gear, license, if so inclined

Reading material, field guides

Unless bulkheads are watertight, all sensitive gear and equipment should be in dry bags, including 2 tapered bags
